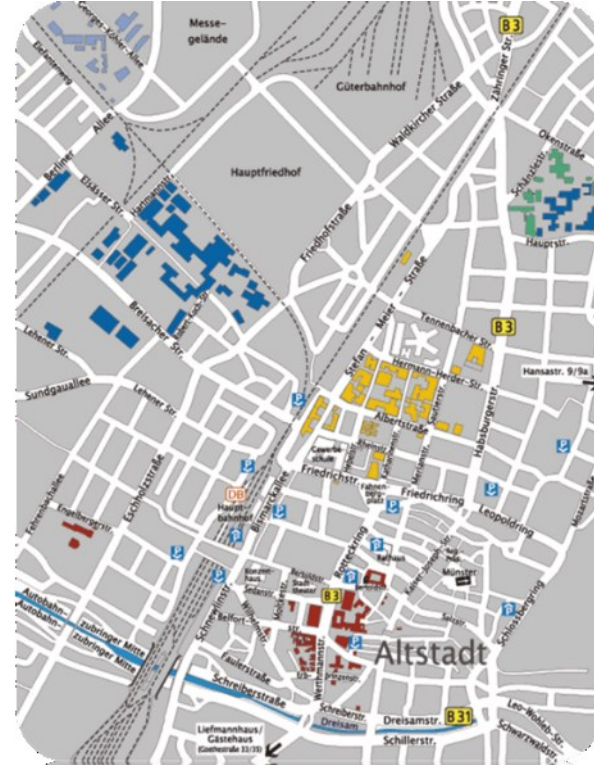

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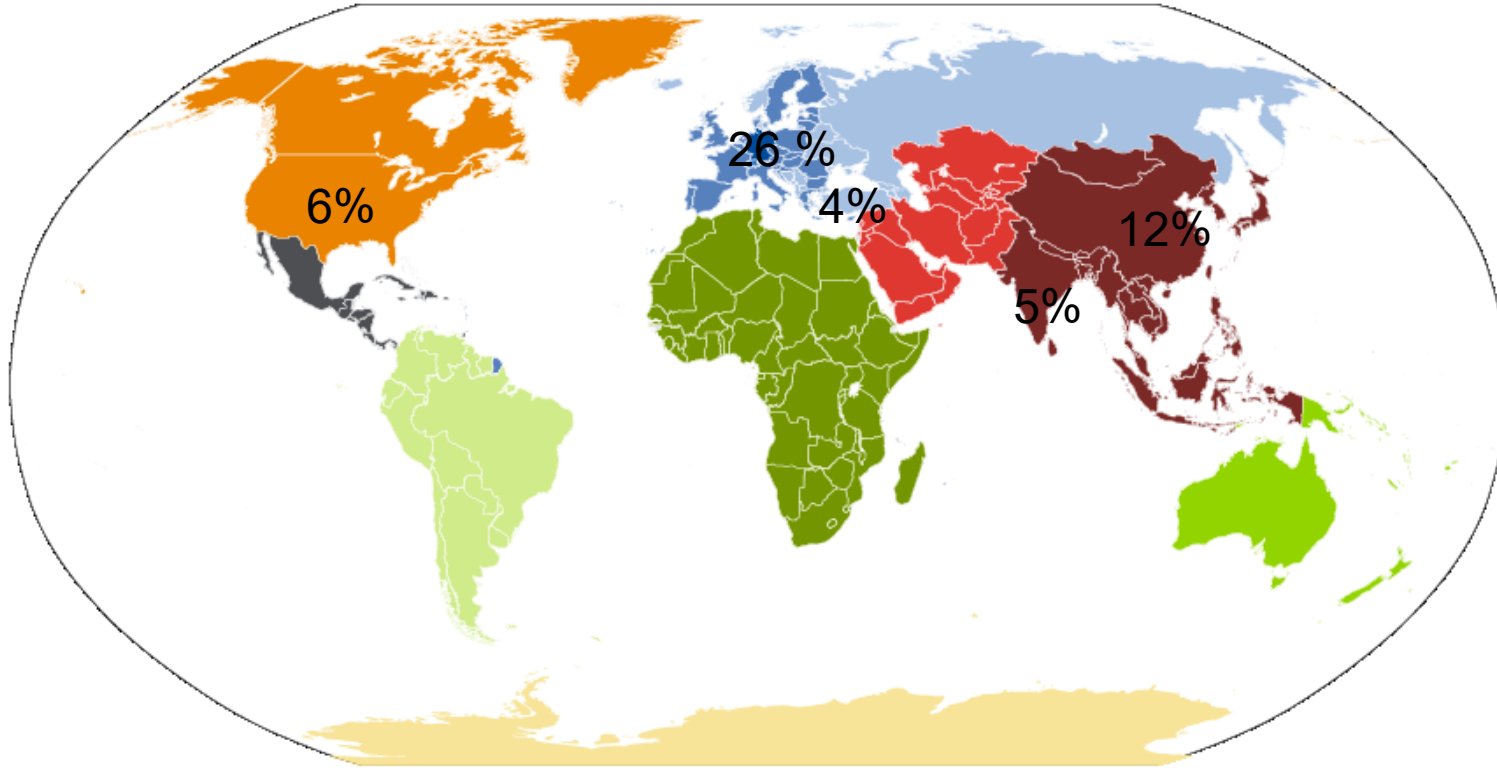
An International University

- Cross-border cooperation with Universities in France and Switzerland (EUCOR – The European Campus & EPICUR)



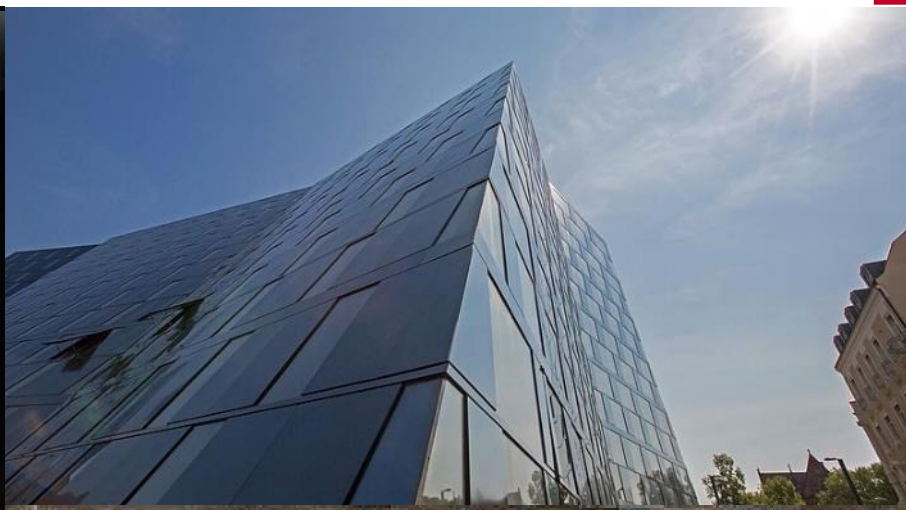

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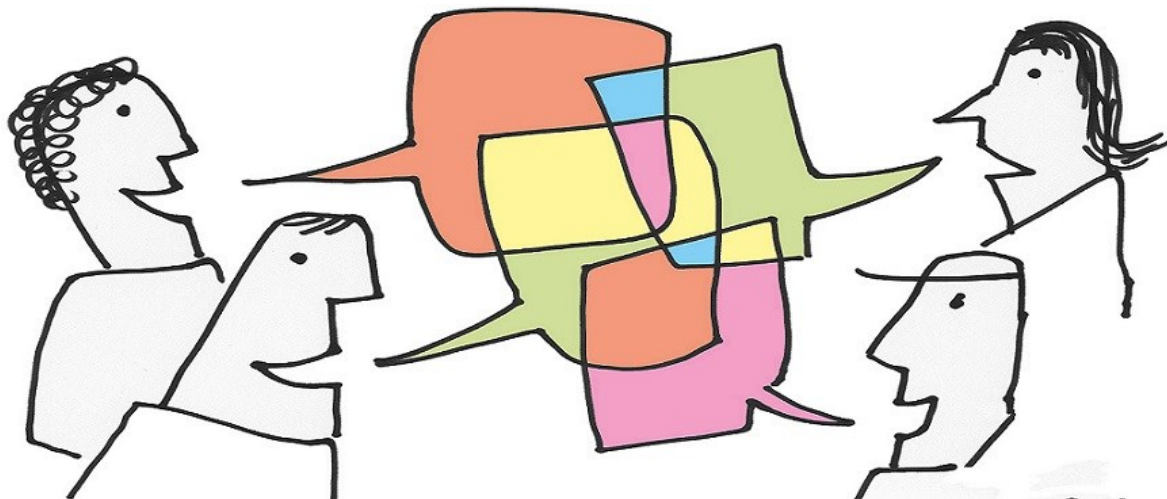

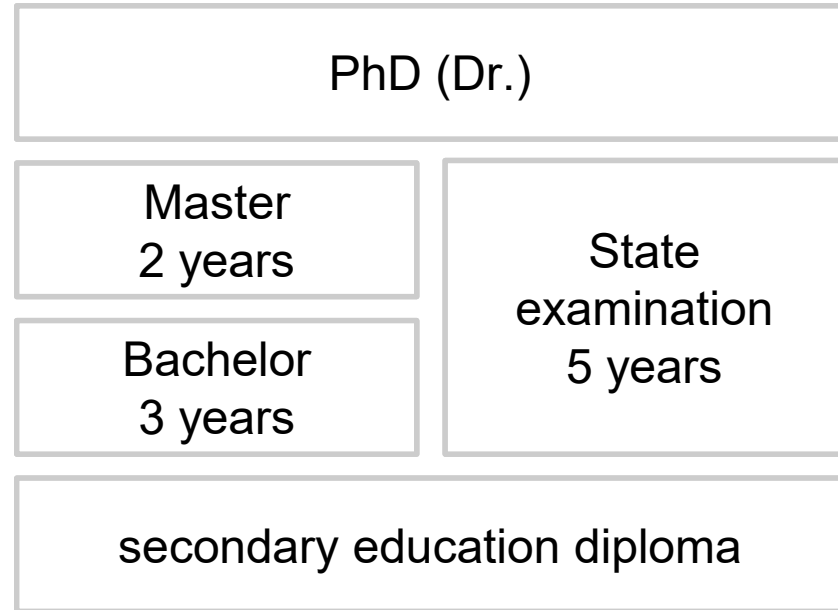


- **Full-time Studies**
You complete an entire course of study at the University of Freiburg and earn a degree (Bachelor, Master, Dr./PhD).
- **Short-time Studies**
You study for one or two semesters as an exchange student at the University of Freiburg.

Credit Points and Academic Performance



- **1 ECTS-Point** = 30 Working Hours
- **Studienleistungen (SL)**
 - Do not count towards the final grade of your degree (pass or fail).
- **Prüfungsleistungen (PL)**
 - Count towards the final grade of your degree. You have to register separately for these exams (graded).
